#### Governance during this term

The Governing body at Whitecross have continued to meet virtually throughout this term to minimise risks to staff and governors and have held two virtual board meetings and two virtual committee meetings (Standards committee and Resources Committee).

Governor meetings have focused on agreeing the School Development Plan and Governing Body objectives for 2021/22 in line with the new school vision and strategy, alongside completing our statutory duties around safeguarding, SEND, health & safety, and policy review.

Some Governors have been able to resume in person Nursery monitoring visits, while following a strict protocol of lateral flow testing and mask wearing. It has been a delight to see the children so happy and engaged in their play and to have the opportunity to speak with the wider staff team.



#### **Parent Events**

We were very pleased that Governors were able to attend the Literacy and Maths parent evenings this term, and the wonderful Christmas performance by the children in the Nursery garden this month. I'm sure all the parents, carers and grandparents who were able to attend one of these performances will agree they were quite magical.   - Further development of daily outdoor learning and implementation of a permanent Forest School provision.
  - Further development of a strong language enriched environment and love of books and stores.
- Agreeing governor objectives and the annual work-planner for 2021/22.
- Reviewing the outcomes of the transition process for children who started Nursery in September.
- Completion of annual review of statutory policies.
- Completion of scheduled finance reviews.
- Completion of health and safety, SEND and safeguarding monitoring visits.
- Completion of Mental Health & Wellbeing monitoring visit.
- Developing governor understanding of latest Ofsted inspection framework.

- Ensure we continue to support the wellbeing of our staff, children and families during the current pandemic and in line with the School Development plan.
