Rational of targets

Analysis of our baseline data demonstrates that our current EYPP children have barriers in the following areas

	Barriers to future attainment
1.	School was reopening after the lockdown earlier in the year from March to June 2020
2.	Due to Covid restrictions we were unable to welcome visitors into school or take the children out of the school on trips
3.	It is unknown how the impact of Covid would affect the children coming into school who had experienced lockdown in their homes during the formative years of their lives.
4.	PSED scores on entry were lower than in previous years
5.	Speech and language scores on entry were lower than in previous years

Work to break down these barriers will take the form of enrichment opportunities through the provision of trips, specialist teaching and free school meals. In addition to this we recognise that pupils who are disadvantaged make greater progress when the pupil to adult ratio is lower so that an increased level of interaction can take place

Desired outcomes in 2022 - 2023

To give all children a positive experience in a happy, nurturing, lively environment where we can focus on enriching PSED and communication and language skills to ensure the mental health and wellbeing of children is at the forefront of everything we do.
