## Outdoor Learning in Nursery

We have we have enjoyed a little bit of good weather at the very start of the term but very quickly it has become autumnal and begun to be damp and wet. Please can you send your child equipped for the change in weather each day? All children need to arrive daily **wearing** their waterproof trousers. They also need to bring a warm waterproof coat daily as all children will learn outside each day whatever the weather. **Please do not send all-in-one puddle suits.** Children need separate elasticated waist waterproof trousers and a coat. Elasticated waist trousers allow your child to be independent at the toilet which is very important. Please can you begin to support your child to learn how to put on their own coat and trousers and also how fasten their own coat independently? Giving children independence with dressing and undressing is a key part of their physical learning curriculum. Also, can you please send a pair of named wellingtons to leave at nursery for children to use for outdoor play? Day shoes should fasten with Velcro rather than buckles or laces to help children confidently swap between shoes and wellies independently. Crocs and soft plimsolls are not appropriate for nursery as they are not good shoes to run and climb in and they do not keep feet dry. Many thanks for your support with this. Being dressed properly will help your child be able to enjoy and make the most of everything nursery has to offer, thank you! ☺

All parents have received links to ClassDojo. Once you activate your account you will be able to see your child's personal learning journey at nursery and follow the school story of activities we enjoy throughout the year. Where there are two parents, both parents of each child will be set up on every child's account. Please share with us photos and information about your child's achievements at home. Staff can then use the pictures to develop speech and language as well as understand more about your child's next steps and learning journey. If you have any issues with using ClassDojo then please ask at the office and we will be happy to help you get started.

## Contacting teachers

Miss Noblet and Mrs Smyth work as a job share. Miss Noblet works Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Mrs Smyth works Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Both can help families with anything. Please be aware that they may not respond to emails or messages on their non-working days.

## Other Reminders

- If your child is absent from school, please inform the school office by phone on the first morning of their absence. If your child has suffered from sickness and diarrhoea, they must to be kept off from school for 48 hours. The germ can remain in their body even if they feel well and easily spread around other children and staff.
- All clothes, bags, coats, shoes, and wellies should be clearly labelled with your child's name. If they are not labelled we cannot guarantee that they will come home with the right clothes. Also if it is written in, please check it regularly as they can wash out!
- It is important that you provide school with the relevant details of who is collecting your child from school. Please inform any member of staff of any changes to the routine. We cannot send children home with adults we were not expecting to collect them. Also a reminder that if you are late to collect your child then we will place them in the care of the after school club and you will be charged for the session they spend there.
- Please ensure children do not wear any jewellery to nursery. We do not permit children to wear real or toy rings, bracelets or necklaces; unless worn for religious reasons. This is because it will get lost, broken or can get caught on play equipment causing injury. Only very small stud earrings are permitted in pierced ears. Thank you

## Lunchtimes and Snacks

- All our children enjoy a social lunchtime together. Children can enjoy a hot lunch provided by school or bring a home packed lunch.
- **Packed lunches cannot contain any nuts or products containing nuts**. Due to allergies we do not have any nuts in the building. Please check the contents of cereal bars and any other products and children cannot have Nutella or chocolate spread in sandwiches.
- Lunchtimes at Whitecross are happy calm times but it does take children a little while to get used to the routines and the food. If there are any issues with children not eating we will let you know but no news is good news.
- Our menu can be found on the school website and on the school notice board.
- Children can have a drink at any time throughout the day and all children are offered a snack of fresh fruit and a carb product such as malt loaf, fruit loaf, crackers, bread sticks, etc. each morning and afternoon. Children can choose milk or water at snack times.
